Video Basics – Equipment

- ▶ You don't need super fancy equipment, but you do need the following
 - Recording device -- either a camera (doesn't have to be DSLR) or a smartphone
 - Recording software
 - (Please, please, please get) [A tripod](#), and/or something to prop your phone up on so that it's steady
 - Good lighting (flash on your phone plus lights)
 - It's a good idea to do this indoors, where lighting and sound can be controlled
 - Test out your equipment by shooting a couple of throwaway scenes

Making a Story

- ▶ Plan out your story before shooting.
- ▶ Write out some talking points and go over them.
 - [Online teleprompter](#)
- ▶ Find a quiet, well-lit place to shoot
- ▶ No one wants to see you talk for two minutes, so add some other media (e.g., pictures).
 - Remember to source pictures if they aren't yours
- ▶ If you're going to add music, make sure it's royalty free and you credit it.

Fun things with Premiere

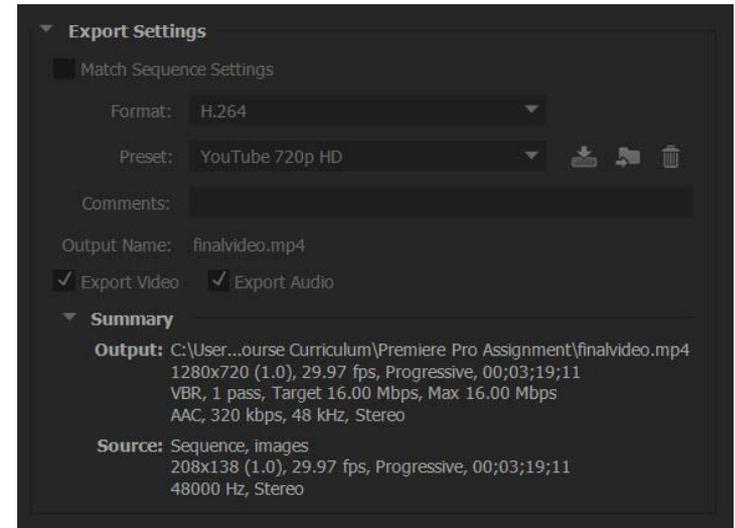
- ▶ Zooming in on pictures
- ▶ Rotating photos
- ▶ Fade transitions
- ▶ Adding titles
- ▶ If your video clip is super zoomed in or super zoomed out, right click on the timeline and select “Scale to Frame Size”

Submitting Your Video

- ▶ If you're using Premiere, follow these steps to export your video to YouTube
File > Export > Media > Export Settings
 - Follow settings
 - Change Output Name to something you'll remember
 - Click Export

Submitting Your Video (cont.)

- ▶ Find the .mp4 file you just exported
 - ▶ Go to YouTube
 - ▶ Set up an account if you don't have one already
 - ▶ Follow the upload instructions on YouTube
 - ▶ Once it's uploaded and you have the link,
TEST OUT THE LINK TO SEE IF IT WORKS
